### BE MINE (signed *Jesus*)

It is February and that means hearts will be everywhere – greeting cards, candies, chocolates, and even underwear (can I say “underwear” in a church publication?)

I remember in first grade when we brought our shoeboxes to school and decorated them for classmates to put valentines in. When I got a valentine from Gina I thought she must be in love with me for sure. Later I realized that we were supposed to give everyone a valentine and it didn't mean that Gina wanted to be mine forever. I was crushed. So much for young love.

You know the saying “love makes the world go ‘round’”? I might change that a bit to be “love has *made the world*”. We might say it was God's love that truly made the world – a creation of love for love. When couples come to me to prepare for their wedding day and wonder about a selection of scripture, I often point them to 1 John 4:7-12. That section of scripture begins “Beloved, let us love one another; for love is of God, and he who loves is born of God and knows God.” The love that a couple brings to the altar is good and beautiful but it is not all there is or should be.

It is the love of God that enables us to love and it is God's love that ultimately gives us life and meaning. Jesus was the manifestation of God's love for us. The popular 1970's song refrain “What the world needs now, is love sweet love – that's the only thing that there's just too little of” does not quite take in account the overwhelming, all-filling, and powerful love of God that is now shown to the world through us. Take that love to the streets people - take it to the hungry, take it to the lonely, take it to the hurting – but first receive it yourself, because I learned in Sunday School, “Jesus loves me, this I know, for the Bible tells me so”.

## To all the Friends of Serenity Inns:

As you may know, once the men have been at the Inn approximately one month, they may be eligible to begin looking for a job. At least one of the men is currently searching for work, and others will soon begin their search. For many, this is their first job in many months or even years.

We're hoping that some of you may have some leads for them, or that you are even in a position to consider hiring them for your own company. This would be quite a blessing for the men involved, as their search for a job can be a daunting task. These men in recovery, who endeavor to return to the workforce, often need to meet someone who understands their situation, and that is why we are turning to you.

There are a few parameters that have to be met before they can accept a job. Please keep in mind the following guidelines as you consider any assistance you might be able to provide:

1. They must work either 1st or 3rd shift, so that they can be present for 6 PM Dinner Fellowship each evening.
2. The job site must be accessible by bus.
3. The men are not allowed to drive.
4. The men must be paid with checks, not cash, and they are not permitted to work on commission.

If there is a test they would have to take as part of the application process, it would be helpful for us to know that in advance.

The men have a variety of skills; but general labor often works out best for them, even if it is not in their original line of work.

## FINANCIAL REPORT

The congregation voted to accept the 2011 budget previous approved by the Church Council at our January annual meeting. The total budget for this year is \$285,098.00. Of that amount, we have budgeted \$270,898 from pledged and projected offerings. In order to reach our goal, we will need **\$22,575** in operating fund and mortgage fund contributions each month.

I will be keeping you posted on the status of our contributions in each edition of “*The Door*”.

Electronic giving is a giving option for you to consider. Not only is it convenient for you, it helps the church in knowing when contributions can be expected. Authorization forms are available on the information kiosk at church.

If you have any questions or concerns about the budget or your specific contributions, please don't hesitate to contact me.

In other news, the outside doors of the church have new locks and those individuals (both church members and outside groups that meet during the week) that need keys have been given them. If you are last to leave church, please make the rounds of all the doors to see that they are locked as well as lights being turned off.
